Touring Israel the Land of Promise



February 19 - Departure

Today you will embark on the journey of a lifetime as you begin your pilgrimage to The Holy Land. Meals served in flight.

February 20 - Arrival

Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, you will be met by your guide. Time permitting, enjoy a driving tour of Biblical **Joppa**, where Jonah fled the call of The Lord. Continue to your Tel Aviv area hotel for dinner & a good night's rest.

February 21 - From Sea to Sea

Start your day at Caesarea by the Sea. This port city includes extensive remains of the theater and other sites, including a Roman aqueduct along the Mediterranean shore. Travel to Mt. Carmel where Elijah prayed down the fire from heaven and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal. Visit Megiddo and look out over the Valley of Armageddon. End your day in Nazareth Village, a modern day recreation of village life during the time of Christ. Continue to Tiberias and check in to your next hotel.

February 22 – The Galilee

Enjoy a beautiful boat ride across the **Sea of Galilee** as you share in a special time of worship on the water. Travel to **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' ministry in Galilee. Stand in the ruins of the synagogue built on the remains of the one where Jesus taught. Visit the peaceful Mount of Beatitudes that overlooks the Sea of Galilee. On this hill, Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. Stop at **Tabgha**, where the feeding of the 5,000 is remembered at the **Church of the Loaves and Fish**. Also stop at the **Chapel of the Primacy**, where Peter confessed his devotion to Christ 3 times. Walk the recent excavations of the town of **Magdala**, the hometown of Mary Magdalene. Explore the massive excavations at Beit Shean, a city continuously inhabited for over 5,000 years, which was part of the Decapolis of Jesus' day.

February 23 – Northern Israel

Journey north to **Caesarea Philippi**, where Peter proclaimed, "You are the Christ". Continue to one of the ancient boundary markers of Israel, **Tel Dan**, and view Abraham's Gate and the alter King Jeroboam built in the north. Travel through the **Golan Heights** and better understand their strategic importance to the security of Israel.

February 24 - Up to Jerusalem

Travel south from the Sea of Galilee through the Jordan Valley to Jerusalem. Stop at Gideon's Spring (Ein Harod), where Gideon chose his army of 300 by observing how they drank from the spring. When you arrive in Jerusalem, stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City." Pray among the olive trees in the Garden of Gethsemane as Jesus did, the night He was betrayed with a kiss. Travel to Mount Zion and stand in the Upper Room, revered as the place of the Last Supper. Check in to your Jerusalem hotel for dinner & overnight.

February 25 - Jerusalem

Conditions permitting, visit the iconic **Temple Mount**, where the Jewish Temple once stood and the Dome of the Rock currently stands. Experience traveling back in time in the **Rabbi's Tunnel**, where foundation stones and other stone work survives from the Second Temple! Walk the **Jewish Quarter** and take time to visit the **Cardo**, a 2,000 year old market with shops old and new. Wander the excavations of the **City of David**.

February 26 - Southern Waters & Ruins

Ascend by cable car to **Masada**, Herod's legendary mountaintop fortress which became the last desperate stronghold of the Jewish Zealots against the Romans. You can still look down on the remains of the Roman camps and the siege ramp below. View **Ein Gedi** – where David sought refuge from King Saul. Travel to **Qumran**, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to learn about the mysterious

community of the Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Gather at the **River Jordan** baptismal site of Kasr el Yehud, the traditional site of the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist. Take an opportunity to float in the renowned salt and mineral-laden waters of the **Dead Sea**.

February 27 - Jerusalem


Wander the halls of the Israel Museum, where you will see the Shrine of the Book, where some of the Dead Sea scrolls are displayed. Visit Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust Memorial, with its poignant exhibits honoring the millions of lives lost during the Holocaust. Sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne, known for its amazing acoustics. Walk the Via Dolorosa ("the Way of the Cross"). See the Ecce Homo Arch which is associated with the condemnation of Jesus by Pilate. Take time to reflect on the agony of the cross at Gordon's Calvary and the miraculous reality of the resurrection at the Garden Tomb!

February 28 - Return

Return home with a lifetime of memories to cherish.
